As we enter the Christmas holiday season, we have been reflecting on the many ways that God has blessed us in 2022. At the beginning of the year, Lifecycles Louisiana was nothing more than a dream that God had planted in our hearts. As we close out the year, Lifecycles has grown into an actual ministry with a growing number of teen boys participating and being challenged to become the men that God intended them to be. We recently completed our first riding season on the weekend of November 12 and 13 with our inaugural challenge ride where 7 teens rode their bikes from Abita Springs to Folsom, LA and back – completing 70 miles with over 2,000 feet of climbing in two days. They braved cold temperatures, rain, strong headwinds, and numerous hills to prove to themselves that they could do far beyond what they thought possible when they started with us. It has truly been a remarkable year and we are very grateful to God for the many ways He has blessed us in this new venture.
